

LEGAL NOTICE

The Lake County Floodplain Administrator has received the following floodplain development permit application and variance requests:

FLATHEAD LAKE BIOLOGICAL STATION FLOODPLAIN DEVELOPMENT PERMIT APPLICATION

Mark Lorang, on behalf of the Flathead Lake Biological Station, has applied for a floodplain development permit for the placement of fill within the 100-year floodplain of Flathead Lake, for the purposes of erosion control. The project includes the placement of 750 cubic yards of gravel along 550 linear feet of shoreline as well as 3 large root wads with 10–20-foot attached stems as log groins. The subject property is legally described as government lots 1 and 2, located within section 04 of T24N, R19W.

MONTANA FWP FLOODPLAIN DEVELOPMENT PERMIT APPLICATION

Mark Lorang, on behalf of Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks (FWP), has applied for a floodplain development permit for the placement of fill within the 100-year floodplain of Flathead Lake, for the purposes of erosion control. The project includes the placement of 912 cubic yards of boulders, cobbles, and gravel materials along 240 linear feet of shoreline. The subject property is legally described as tract A on COS 4384, located within section 019 of T26N, R19W.
